Roadworks

As we write this newsletter, the Parish is having a very challenging time with roadworks along The Mile, which are affecting residents in many ways. Longer, slower routes for residents, school buses, businesses struggling to get deliveries, speeding and increased volumes of traffic through narrow single-track roads, customers getting to The Gait Inn and The Ramblers' Rest. The list is endless. We have been informed that all work should be completed by 17th July 2026, LETS HOPE SO!

The Parish Council spoke with Highways regarding further closures to Kilnwick Lane and to The Balk in Millington which were planned for June and early July. We have managed to get these closures postponed until after The Mile reopens.
